THE VICTORIA POLICE OPTIONS MODEL

In Response to and Investigation of Family Violence

In attending a family violence incident Police must:

- Assess the immediate threat and risks
- Manage the incident
- Assess the level of future protection required.

Police must take the most appropriate course of action from one or more of the following options.

Criminal

Legal action to charge a person with an offence e.g. arrest and court appearance.

Civil

Legal action to protect rights, a non-criminal measure e.g.

- Issue a Safety Notice
- Apply for an Intervention Order
- Apply for a change to an existing order.

Referral

To support services for everyone involved.
