The Week Without Violence (WWV) is a worldwide campaign that occurs in the third week of October, each year. This year's WWV will be held between 14-20 October 2019.

The campaign aims to raise community awareness of family violence, encourage healing through art and strengthen local connections and relationships focused on the prevention of violence against women. WWV activities have been facilitated across the northern metropolitan region of Melbourne through local family violence networks since 1999.
