## **Family Violence Intake Pathways: Perpetrators**

Police may issue a Family Violence Safety Notice and initiate a civil justice response (Family Violence Intervention Order). They may also initiate a criminal process. If the risk to the victim survivor is high, a referral may be made to a Risk Assessment Management Panel (RAMP).
